*The old outfall pipe from pond #24, in back of Mary Ann Graham’s home, ran under the cart path at #2 Tee box and into the marsh. Two new 24” drains and a control box spillway were installed there. Eighty feet of cart path was rebuilt because of an irrigation line, located under the old cart path. This work began March 3<sup>rd</sup> and was the first stage of recreating a much safer and environmentally friendly storm water system up to an inlet grate at Clubhouse Drive.*
